# OGDEN FIRE DEPARTMENT TURNS 150

On August 5th of this year, the Ogden Fire Department is celebrating their 150th anniversary. In the 1870's, Ogden was a large center for travelers heading West, thanks to the Union Station and the connection of railroads across the United States. The city was developing at a rapid pace. Then, on August 5th, 1874, a devastating fire broke out at three in the morning. Nine buildings were destroyed.

According to the current fire department historian and medical captain, Ashley Phillips, the fire started "as a result of spontaneously igniting phosphorus at the center of Main Street (common-day Washington Boulevard). The fire began in the middle of the night at Higginbottom and Co. Drugstore and rapidly spread to nearby buildings." This was the beginning of "The Bucket Brigade" in Ogden. Citizens and neighbors would form a line and pass buckets of water or other firefighting tools down the line toward the fire. The fire was spreading so quickly that the buildings to the sides of the origin of the fire were torn down. "The technique worked and likely saved Ogden from being scorched from the earth, but the effects of the damage were undeniable," Phillips said. Ogden was in desperate need of an organized fire department.

In October of 1874, Ogden created the Volunteer Firemen of Ogden. Joshua Williams became Ogden's first Fire Chief. This volunteer group ran until 1916, with many people giving their time and efforts to keep the city safe. The firemen who weren't volunteers began to be paid in 1879. Then, in 1881, a large fire destroyed the freight offices of the Southern and Union Pacific Rail Companies. This prompted Ogden City Council to pass multiple ordinances and approve the creation of Engine Company No. 1 and Hook and Ladder Company No. 1.

By the 1890's the fire department started to be a more formal operation. Most personnel were being paid at this point, so the volunteers moved their equipment from 25th and Washington to Five Points on 2nd Street.



In 1891, the first official Ogden fire station was built on 26th Street and Grant Avenue. This building was dedicated strictly to firefighting, unlike the mixed-use building that was being used prior. They used horse drawn hand pumps, steamer engines, hose carts, and ladder trucks.

A few years later in 1895, prisoners attempted to escape the building by setting it on fire. Then in 1898, Park City sent Ogden a telegram asking for assistance with a great fire. Steamer No. 1 and Wagon No. 2 were sent by train to Park City, where they found the city nearly wiped out. It took 11 hours straight to get the fire out.

The 1900's saw even more developments. By 1917, most of Ogden's fire equipment was no longer horse drawn. Ogden was compared to the Chicago Fire Department for using "chemical engines." In 1923, there was a blaze that burnt down Union Station on 25th Street. In 1939, the city built a new Central Fire Station on 320 26th Street. In 1945, Clyde L. Peterson became Fire Chief.

Chief Peterson expanded the Ogden Fire Department in 1946. He had a new station built and added more firefighters to the department, as well as adding two-way radios to the department's equipment. Ogden City contributed to the department in 1949 by purchasing box alarms for remote alerting to fires around Ogden.

In 1955, one of the first paid firefighters visited the station. Ted West was 88 when visiting, and he was in awe of the changes the department had been through since his retirement. West stated that firefighters would stay at the station for ten straight days, with exceptions of forty minutes three times a day to go home for meals.

In the 1960's, Chief Peterson advocated for more firefighters and stations. Ogden had three stations at the time. Ogden City approved the building of a new station, as well as hiring more personnel for the department. Throughout the 60's and into the 70's, the fire department unionized. Some thought Chief

Peterson had lost touch with the department. The firefighters wanted an increase in pay, as a survey found Ogden firefighters were underpaid. They also wanted affordable life, health, and accidental insurance.

The training tower opened in February of 1975. With it came foam systems for the department and federally funded paramedic training at Weber State University. There was also a new emergency control board that became the nerve center for the department. Fire personnel could now talk to crews and other stations, individually or all at once. An arsonist set Golden Spike Coliseum on fire in 1993, resulting in a total loss of the building. No one was caught. This was the same year that our current Fire Chief, Mike Mathieu, became Chief.

The Shupe-Williams Candy building burnt to the ground in March of 2006. It was 100 years old, and the city had been determining whether to remodel or demolish the building. Firefighters couldn't enter the building; it was too unstable. As the building burned down, a large crowd watched.

What began as a volunteer effort in the 1870's has evolved into the top-tier professionals we see today. Ogden has had many more fires in its history, and the fire department has shown excellence and professionalism throughout it all. There are currently 136 operations firefighters and 12 administrative personnel, with five stations total in Ogden. Just last year, Ogden Fire responded to roughly 21,200 calls: 18,735 medical and 2,473 fire calls. Despite their busy lines, Ogden Fire Department has remained constantly dedicated to the public. The department helps set up city events, and they talk and read to children on Dr. Seuss days. They also have a program, Boots and Bunkers, which provides life and fire safety tips to over 150,000 kids a year.

Ogden Fire Department is celebrating 150 years of operation with a public celebration and open house on August 5th at Ogden Station No. 1. This event runs from 5-8pm. The address is 2186 Lincoln Avenue.

The Marshall White Center has been a staple of Ogden since it opened in 1968. As a recreational facility, many children and adults have utilized the classes and activities offered. The decades came and went, and the building stood proudly on the corner of 28th Street and Lincoln Avenue. Then, slowly, time caught up to the building. In 2018, the pool had to close. The roof started leaking. The walls were cracking. While the city patched what they could, it was obvious that the building needed to be redone entirely.

Marshall White, the Black man the building is named after, was a World War II veteran, a healthcare provider, president of NAACP Ogden, and an Ogden police officer. He was known for speaking against discrimination. White was also an advocate for improved recreational facilities, especially in west Ogden, where children of color and poorer families lived. In October of 1963, White was shot, and he died three days later from the injury. He was the first Black

police officer in Utah killed in the line of duty. The Marshall White Center was built and dedicated to White five years after his death.

The center's future did not look bright for a while between 2018 and 2021. In November of 2021, during a meeting about the future of the building, members of the community pleaded their cases for keeping the center and rebuilding it in the same location as the first. The community support turned the tide of the conversation. Council members argued that the center wasn't getting enough use, and the public proved the opposite was true. The building had been saved.

Plans moved forward to construct the new building. Funds were drawn from multiple sources, including federal funds, city investments, grants, and donations from the public. The current plan boasts of a 68,000 square foot building. There will be a pool, a teaching kitchen, an indoor track, basketball courts, and more.

The old 37,000 square foot building was torn down last year in the summer of 2023. Since then, a few events

have occurred. On July 18th, 2023, officials held a ceremonial groundbreaking to begin construction on the new center. The estimated build time is between 18-24 months. The completion and opening of the new Marshall White Center is projected to be either February or March of 2025. In December of 2023, officials stated that the center is still on track for that timeframe. In January of 2024, artists were encouraged to apply to help decorate the building.

While construction is occurring, the activities offered by the Marshall White Center have not ceased. Multiple facilities have offered a temporary home for painting, swimming, and more. Some of these partners include Ogden City Recreation, Golden Hours Senior Recreation Center, Project Success Coalition, Kitchen Kneads, Lorin Farr Pool, and the Weber County Library. # MARSHALL WHITE

## THE MAN BEHIND THE LEGEND

United States Army buildings are named after men who have died in the line of duty— fallen heroes. Inside those buildings are monuments to the fallen, telling their story of why the honor is theirs. The city of Ogden has its own fallen hero and, like the Army's fallen, he has a building named after him.

But what is a name on a building? Is it there for the sake of being there, or should it symbolize something? The Marshall N. White Center in downtown represents a lot of things to a lot of people, but who was the man?

White is the first and only African American police officer killed in the line of duty in Utah. Before becoming a police officer, he was a licensed podiatrist who found it difficult— being a black man in a predominantly white community—to build a clientele, and thus successful prac-

tice in Ogden. He turned to serving the people of his community as a police officer, serving in that capacity for 15 years, eventually reaching the rank of Detective Sergeant. His son Winston, who lived in Ogden for a time and who now resides in Las Vegas, commented on what he wants people to know about his father.

"He was very educated. He got his degree from the Northwest Institute of Chicago in 1930. He was one of three blacks in his graduating class."

Helping build the community, particularly the ethnic community, was a lifelong goal of White's. He started the Ogden chapter of the NAACP and served as its president. "He was our Martin Luther King. He stood up for our rights in Ogden City. He witnessed some injustices to people and tried to help make up for it," Winston said of his father's community work.

Outside of his official community status as police officer and

president of an organization, White was well loved by his friends. Joe McQueen, local jazz musician and entertainer, met White in Salt Lake City in 1946 and says the two became fast friends. The two spent time together fishing and hunting. He also said that the two spent time talking about current events and moments in history. "He was a nice guy and a good friend of mine," McQueen said. "In the first place, people called him 'Doc.' He was a good man and a good police officer. He was one of the best marksmen on the Ogden Police Department."

Not many people knew much about him. McQueen was also familiar with White's work as a podiatrist. "He worked on my feet twice and I haven't had any problems with them since. That was almost 50 years ago." When McQueen first heard of White's death he was "knocked for a loop," he said. "Everybody was impacted. I didn't expect it to happen to him. It blew me away."

On his father's death, Winston said, "It changed the direction of my life. He has a name I have had to try to live up to. It was really hard, I found as I got older."




Winston compares his father's death, which occurred one month before President John F. Kennedy's assassination, to the grief experienced by a whole nation. "Around that time every black person was grieving. It set a different tone for how I dealt with my father's death. Violence pervaded my youth. To me, my father's death was the beginning of a time of death and grieving by the whole country."

Having your name adorn the side of a building is an honor, but there is perhaps no bigger honor than having people know you, remember you, then say "yes, he deserves that honor."



Caesura is an innovative performance art piece composed based on historically significant train routes, meticulously identified and researched by Chacon and Galindo. The title “Caesura” refers to the musical term for a pause, often depicted as “railroad tracks.” This shape-shifting composition utilizes alleged “hobo code” symbols as notations for performers’ movements between instruments, creating a nomadic language of sound. “Caesura” is designed to be realized specifically at Ogden Union Station, responding to and adapting to the unique characteristics of the location. The performance acknowledges the diverse communities shaped, transported, and left behind by the train tracks, invoking the social and economic divisions facilitated by modern transportation and commercial expansion.

This piece is a percussive symphony created from detritus sourced from old railroad infrastructure. Performers will engage with these objects by striking, rolling, scratching, and sounding them together. Some performers will remain in fixed positions, while others will move from station to station across a mapped area, following a series of dynamic instructions. The result is a transient-rich, percussive score that varies in both volume and location of sound sources.

This performance is part of OCA’s current exhibit, The Other Side of the Tracks, curated by Jorge Rojas. The exhibit and performance aim to engage the public through thought-provoking art that reflects on the impact of historical and contemporary transportation systems on



# DISK GOLF IN OGDEN

Disc Golf has been gaining popularity in the United States, especially after the peak of the COVID-19 pandemic. This relatively cheap, easy to pick up sport gained further popularity in the Ogden area in 2021, when Fort Buenaventura hosted the PDGA Disc Golf World Championships. What is Disc Golf, and where can it be played in Ogden?

Eric "Yasha" Bond has been playing Disc Golf since 2012, and it's his therapy. A friend sold him discs at a discounted rate. "The most basic explanation of the sport is to throw modified Frisbees into a basket. The 'modified Frisbees' that are used are called 'discs,' hence the term 'Disc Golf,'" Yasha said. Disc flight depends on the disc type used. Yasha cautions that long range discs are not made for catching. Their sharp edges pierce through the air. "The end goal is the same; put an object in a target in the fewest strokes possible," Yasha stated. The metal baskets have chains to catch the discs.

Another Disc Golf enthusiast turned his passion into a business. Cody Nebeker has been playing since his friend introduced him to the sport. He eventually

opened Distracted, a Disc Golf equipment shop located in Fort Buenaventura. "There weren't any local stores, and I saw a huge need in the community," Nebeker said, adding, "I love helping my community. I sell happiness and fun." Despite heavy flooding in 2023 that caused Fort Buenaventura and Distracted to close during peak Disc Golf season, Distracted business is doing well. The Disc Golf season falls between April and October.

There are multiple groups who play Disc Golf throughout Ogden. NUDGA Sunday Leagues meets at the Riverpark Disc Golf Course in Riverdale on Sundays at 9:10am. Another local league is Flex at the Fort, hosted by Yasha and Nebeker; they meet at The Fort Disc Golf Course in Fort Buenaventura on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays.

Ogden has several locations to play Disc Golf. An easy way to find these places is with a phone app called UDisc Disc Golf. The app offers a "courses" tab to find local courses. The "Events" tab lists all upcoming events happening around the user. The "More" tab provides scorecards and other helpful playing tools, such as official rules and stores, community

forums, and more.

Take a look below for locations in the Ogden area to play Disc Golf. Note that The Fort location is a \$4 fee per round.





# art cooperatives ogden

When it comes to art, Ogden sets itself apart with four art cooperatives in the heart of downtown. These spaces are monumental for local artists to show and sell their art, and some artists even teach art classes. Each location offers unique, handmade pieces that cannot be found anywhere else. Because of this, locals and tourists alike purchase pieces knowing they have supported local artists while additionally gaining an irreplaceable memento. One point that has been stressed by each cooperative is that the Ogden community plays a large role in supporting and uplifting local artists.



**Gallery 25** is located at 268 Historic 25th Street. This cooperative began in 2002 with eight people. Only one of the original members remains, and his name is Mac Stevenson. Gallery 25 currently has 50 artists with a waiting list. The

curator is David Crowther. The cooperative takes 20% commission for main artists and 30% for guest artists, a much lower rate than most galleries. Gallery 25 features paintings, woodcarving, pottery, paper art, custom silver jewelry, glass, prints, greeting cards, and more. They showcase art during First Friday and recently hosted an auction for underprivileged kids to go to camp.



**The Local Artisan Collective**, which can be found at 2371 Kiesel Avenue, is another place where artists thrive. Local Artisan has 30 artists in their store. They sell everything from stickers and soap to jewelry and fine art. Stephanie and Jenny, the owners of the shop, pride themselves on having prices inclusive of all economic backgrounds. Local Artisan offers art classes almost every day, ranging from watercolor to silversmithing. Other events include Little

Artisan Market, a K-12 artist experience that happens twice a year. Occasionally, they host craft swaps to trade supplies, and they do a clothing swap every quarter.



## Dirt Roads Couture

is located at 2422 Grant Avenue and is owned by Tamara Phillips and Lisa Peterson. It is a small boutique with the motto "community over competition." This cooperative hosts 30 local makers in their shop, with a rotation around every three months. Dirt Roads sells loose leaf tea, jewelry, glass products, ink paintings, honey, and custom graphic apparel on demand. They advertise their artists on Instagram, Facebook, and TikTok. They host monthly pop-ups in the spring and summer in the Union Grill parking lot, where they bring an additional 40 artists to set up their art.



**Fiction** is situated at 2717 Washington Boulevard. This charming art cooperative is a co-creative space with six small businesses in their studio and 30 local makers in their shop. The local makers live between Ogden and Salt Lake. Products in this coop include loose-leaf tea, glass objects, letter press cards, photography, watercolor and oil art, beeswax candles, ceramics, secondhand clothing, records, candles, jams, jewelry, a mini makeup bulk refill station, and more. The studio cannot be rented, but artists can email Fiction about selling in their store. Fiction does pop-ups and sidewalk sales, participates in First Friday, and offers herbal and glass classes monthly.
